CR-X	CR-X	Debate Definition of Terms: <i>Stock Issues (Voting Issues):</i> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Topicality: Plan is within bounds of resolution. • Inherency: Problems exist in the status quo and will not be fixed. • Significance: Degree of importance attached to issues; disadvantages may apply here. • Solvency: Plan solves, achieves goals, or produces results claimed; disadvantages may apply here. Additional Terms: <u>Dropped Argument:</u> an argument not addressed in the subsequent speech. <u>Fiat Power:</u> the Affirmative's power to enact the plan. <u>Status Quo:</u> the way things exist in current system. <u>Harms:</u> problems in status quo. <u>Advantages:</u> benefits from adopting Affirmative plan. <u>Disadvantages:</u> consequences Negative claims flow from Affirmative plan- can be a voting issue. <u>Goals:</u> results to be achieved. <u>Criteria:</u> a standard to measure achievement of a goal.	Tips for Oral Critique: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Share your impression of the overall flow of the round. • Share your own knowledge of status quo issues. • Balance suggestions with positive feedback. • Constructive suggestions could address items that would improve clarity, delivery style, arguments, refutation or cross-ex. • Make all comments without giving away your decision. • Take the level of experience of the debater into consideration. • Make sure all debaters come away encouraged.
